IMPORTANT NOTICE

CHANGES TO COVERAGE FOR TESTING AND TREATMENT FOR COVID-19

As a member of Suburban Health Consortium, your school district provides health care benefits to eligible employees and dependents through Suburban Health Consortium's group health plan. Below is important information regarding your health care benefits.

In accordance with the Families First Coronavirus Response Act and Ohio Department of Insurance Bulletin 2020-05, Suburban Health Consortium has made the following changes to your coverage for testing and treatment for COVID-19, effective retroactively to January 27, 2020:

- Testing for COVID-19 is covered with no member cost sharing. Testing covers the cost of the test, as well as the cost of the provider visit, which could include a telehealth (telemedicine), urgent care or emergency room visit, to determine whether the COVID-19 testing is required, and the visit to administer the test.
- All treatment related to COVID-19 diagnoses is covered as an emergency service, at the in-network benefit level.
